



## **ATDML September Virtual Crop**

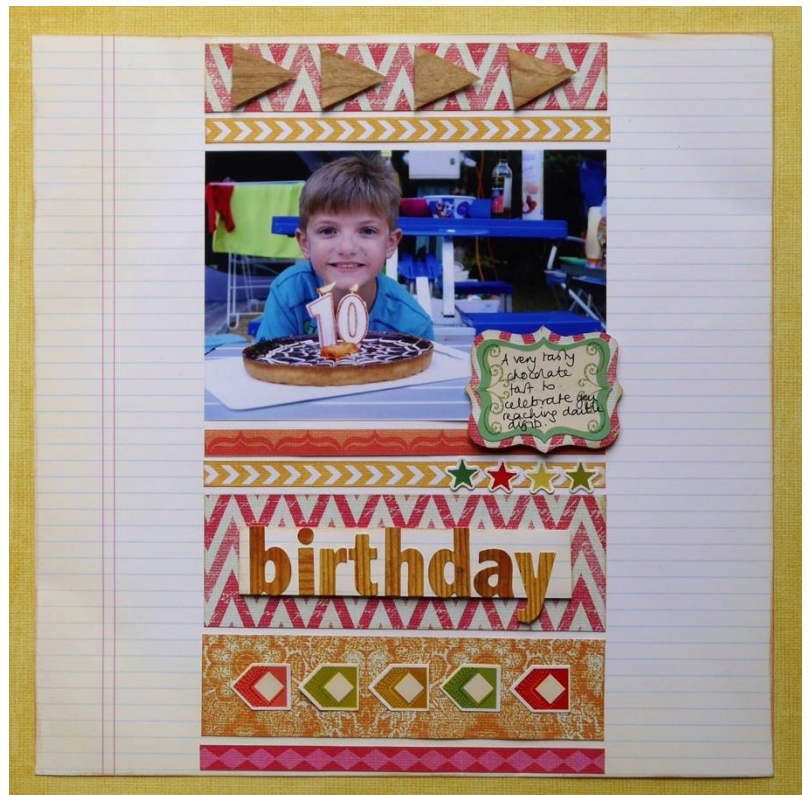
Papers "Tropical Punch" by Kaisercraft

Before we start...

I use tea dye distress ink (which is brown) to ink all my edges. I have used the strips from the bottom of the papers, so don't throw them away. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> layout I use a 1" punched circle and a boarder punch – mine is Martha Stewarts doily lace.

### **Layout 1**

- Cut 1" off the top and 1" off the right hand side of the Scenic Route lined paper and ink the edges
- Gut the yellow (Refreshing) Kaisercraft paper by cutting an 8" square out of the middle. Then stick the Scenic Route paper onto the yellow background.
- All of the strips down the middle are 6" wide, starting from the top cut
  - Cocktail (pink chevron) 6" by 1"
  - yellow chevron paper strip (bottom of the paper)
  - your photo
  - The orange bracket paper strip (bottom of the paper)
  - Yellow chevron paper strip (bottom of the paper)
  - Cocktail (pink chevron) 6" by 2"
  - Lemonade (orange) 6" by 1 ½"
  - Pink diamond border strip (bottom of the paper)

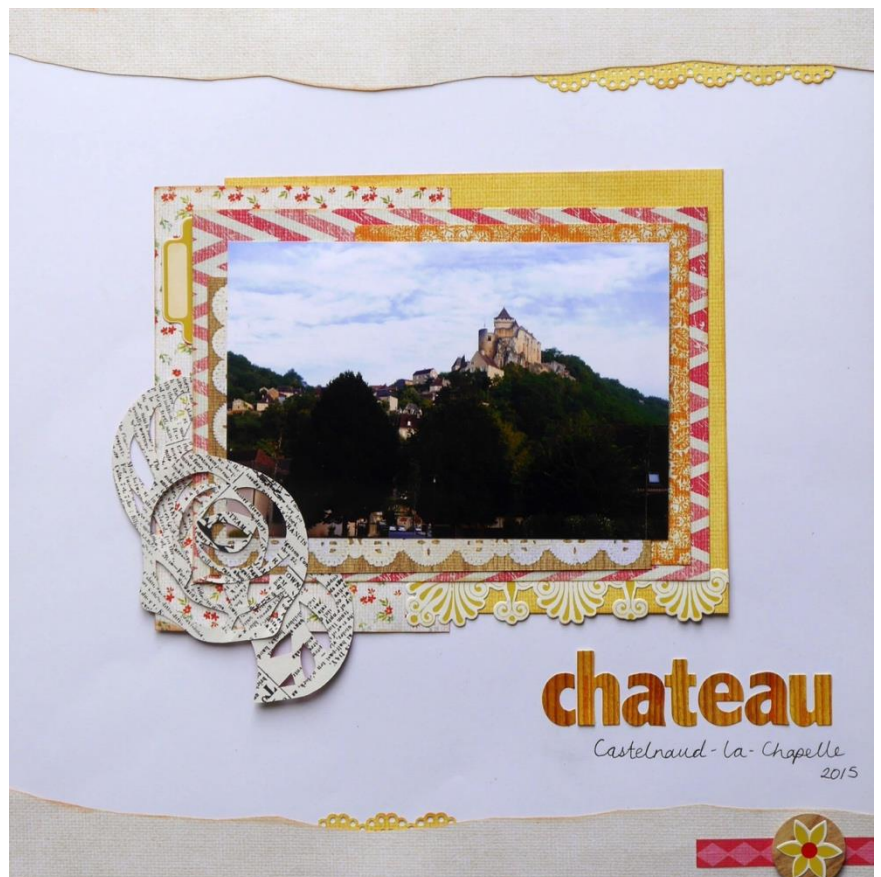


- Ink all the edges and stick on the paper with your photo too.
- Decorate the top strip (cocktail/pink chevron) with woodgrain triangles. Take 1" off the top part of the woodgrain 3 by 4" journal card – so it is 1" by 3". Then marked on the back at ½" intervals, top and bottom, and join the dots to get a triangular pattern (see the photo). Cut and ink the edges and then mount on foam dots along the top paper band.
- For my title I used the remains of the top 1" strip cut from the Scenic route paper and cut it to size with my title. Ink the edges and mount on foam dots.
- Add the house shape Cosmo Cricket stickers along the orange (Lemonade) band of paper.
- Add 4 stars to the yellow chevron stripe underneath the photo.
- Use the blue journal sticker and mount it on some Cocktail (pink chevron) paper and cut around, again I inked the edges and then stick it down with foam dots.



## Layout 2

- Cut a 2" strip of the Lemonade (orange/cream) paper, then cut it in half with scissors so you get a wiggly edge – this is what I used for the top and bottom of the white cardstock. Ink the edges.
- Cut a 1" strip from the yellow Refreshing paper, and then punch it. Ink the edges and tuck a couple of pieces behind the cream Lemonade paper. I used a small bit at the bottom and longer at the top. Stick these 2 bands to the bottom and top of your paper. I found that my cardstock was slightly wider than the papers so I trimmed off the white edge.
- Cut the layers for behind the photo, you will need



- 6 by 4" floral journal card (we use the reverse)
  - 6 by 4" woodgrain and doily journal card
  - Lemonade paper (orange) cut 4 ½" square
  - Cocktail (pink chevron) 7" by 5"
  - Refreshing (yellow) 6 by 6 ¾"
- Ink the edges of all the papers and the die cut rose and leaves.
  - Layer up the papers behind your photo as shown in my picture, once you are happy with the arrangement staple the pieces in a few places in the centre – if you stick them down you need to be able to lift up the places where the stickers and rose go around the left and bottom of these papers. You can always add more glue under the layers at the end.
  - Stick the paper pile onto the white cardstock as well as your photo onto the top.
  - Add 3 swirls of the yellow sticker border under the pink chevron (cocktail) paper. Add the leaves for the rose, the bottom is tucked under the woodgrain doily card, and the top leaf under the cocktail (pink chevron) card, the rose then goes on the top. I stuck this with little bits of wet glue.
  - Add a 2" strip of the diamond paper border (bottom of the page strip) at the bottom corner of your page, punch out a 1" circle from the remains of the woodgrain journal card used in the 1<sup>st</sup> layout and then stick the flower from the stickers on top.
  - Add your title.
